To have fun	To not yell at players, coaches, Association board members, Polar Ice staff, referees, officials, or other parents
To remember that this is a youth sport	To be respectful and positive in the stands during games
To be as positive, supportive, encouraging and helpful as possible	To let the coaches coach and be supportive of the teams and Association in general
To help create positive youth sports environment as possible	To remove myself from situations where I'm feeling angry, and adhere to the 24-hour rule before contacting either the Manager or Coach to discuss the issue
To help my player get to the arena on time and be ready to play	To neither put up with abuse, nor be abusive and to report any such incidences appropriately
To call one of the coaches or managers in advance if my player cannot attend a practice or game	To remember that this is not professional hockey
To show respect, fairness, fair play, integrity, dignity and reasonableness	The Association encourages "Fair" ice time, but does not require "Equal" ice time. There may be situations where less skilled players receive less ice time during games than more skilled players may. All players receive the same ice time during practices
To help out and volunteer when needed, or as opportunities arise (i.e., scorekeeping, phone tree, penalty box, fundraising, assist Team Manager as necessary, etc.),	To pay hockey payments when due

I understand that failure to comply with one or more of the above will have consequences depending on the severity of the situation. It can result in temporary or permanent suspension from the team, program and Association.
